Our Teachers

Sahar Samara (Egypt) ~ is currently the hottest rising star in Cairo, a protégé of Aida Nour and star dancer of the Blue Nile River Boat. She began her professional dance career as a member of Tito's folklore troupe. Soon she was a popular soloist and she was prompted to move her career to Cairo. Her style is unique and blends both classic and modern in her Oriental work and her folkloric repertoire is breathtaking. Sahar was a participant in Dina's competition show "Al Rakesa" which catapulted her into the international belly dance scene. She is highly sought-after as a performer and instructor throughout the world as well as at prestigious festivals in Egypt.

Saqra (USA) ~ is a veteran of belly dance, an acclaimed performer, instructor and choreographer with numerous instructional DVDs to her name. She is known for her challenging technical skill, her ability to break down material for all dancers, and her warm and approachable demeanour. www.saqra.net
